

Painting a Stormtrooper/Clone

Level: very beginner

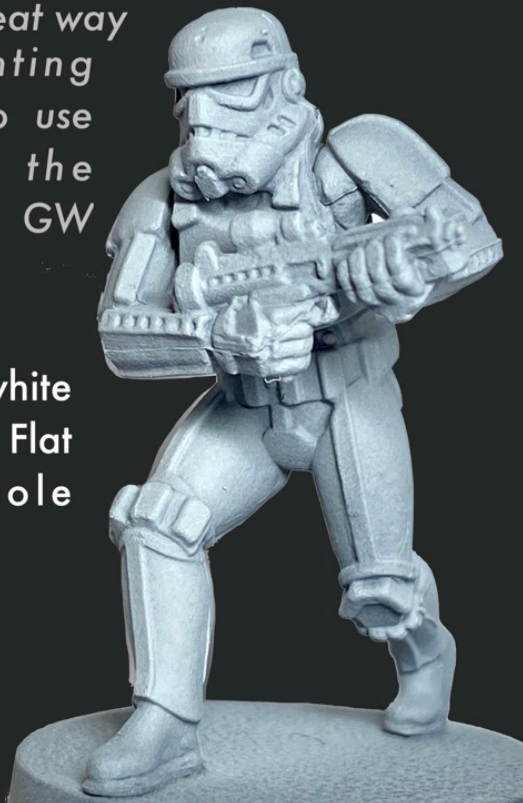


PART II

1. Introduction, priming

In this second part I will only use GW's Contrast Colours. They are a great way to start with painting miniatures. Be sure to use matte primers or the primers provided by GW for Contrast Colours.

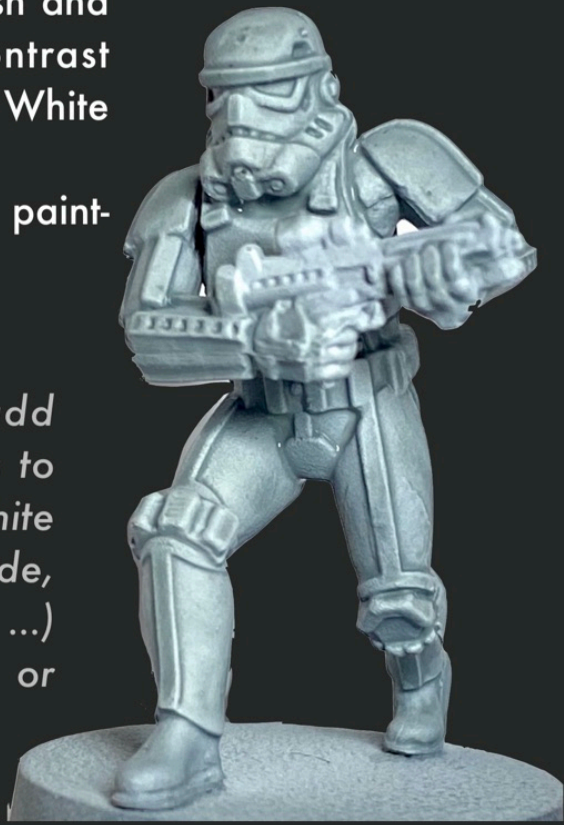
I applied a matte white (airbrush, AK RC004 Flat White) to the whole model.



2. Base colour

I took a 0-sized brush and applied GW's Contrast Colour Apothecary White to the whole model. Try to avoid larger paint-pools. Let the paint dry.

You could also add some darker colours to the Apothecary White (e.g. Skeleton Horde, Space Wolves Grey, ...) to achieve a darker or dusty appearance.



3. Black parts

Apply GW's Contrast Colour Black Templar (or any black paint) to the gun, some parts of the helmet, gloves and the black under-suit.



4. Result, last steps
